Musical instruments have a wide variety when it comes to quality, features, and cost. For most students, a beginner-level instrument is the best option to get started. As students progress as musicians, many find it very beneficial to upgrade to a Professional or Intermediate level instrument. As a parent, this can be a daunting thing to face with many brands to choose from, hundreds of different models, many customizable options, and price tags that range well into the thousands.

We know picking the right instrument can feel overwhelming, so we teamed up with many professional musicians and educators to create a trusted list for each instrument. While you're free to choose any make or model, our goal is to make the decision easier and give you peace of mind. Every option on our list is well-loved, reliable, sounds great, and offers great value—so you can feel confident in your investment.



DIFFERENCES IN BEGINNER, INTERMEDIATE AND PROFESSIONAL

Beginner instruments are designed with emphasis on durability and low cost. They are made to withstand more wear-and-tear from younger students. This means that they are made from materials and designs that can limit their playability as a trade-off.

Higher level instruments are made from superior quality materials which allow musicians to play with a richer, fuller sound and far more ability to create wonderful musical expression. For example, flutes and brass instruments typically contain a higher silver content. Clarinets are constructed from unique woods rather than plastic. There are also differences in available features and functions. Flutes, saxophones and trombones feature extra keys or tubing to extend their range and provide alternative fingerings for enhanced control while playing. Many are handcrafted.

An important consideration when investing in a more expensive instrument is retention of value. Instruments that are considered to be “Professional” models will cost more, but in most cases retain their value far better than an Intermediate level instrument. We strongly suggest to consider the price difference in Pro and Intermediate, and how well each should hold their value.

Finally, your student's goals for music should be considered. If they have expressed interest in continuing through multiple grades and into college bands, or if they want to audition for honor bands, top-chair, or take private lessons, these are good indications that your student would benefit greatly from upgrading to a higher level instrument.

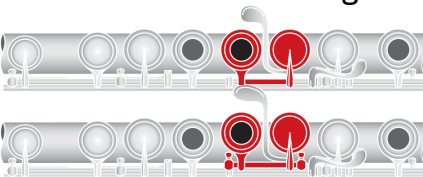

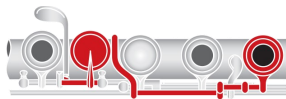
COMMON OPTIONS TO CUSTOMIZE FLUTES

Upgrade flutes have a number of options that help create the perfect "fit" and improve abilities. All models can be configured to suit the individual player.



Inline G (top) vs Offset G

Offset G keys are designed to fit the natural shape of the player's left hand by moving the key slightly closer to the hand. Inline G flutes keep the G keys in the same line as all the other body keys. Choose the style that is most comfortable.



Split E

This mechanism physically splits the double G keys. When playing G, the keys behave as normal, closing both of the G keys. For high E, the mechanism closes the lower of the two G keys. This creates ideal venting for this note and therefore makes this usually troublesome note very stable. The high E speaks easier, and slurs from high A to E are much easier.



C# Trill

The C# trill key is one of the most popular mechanism options and gives the player a lot of options when playing. These include:

Using one finger for a B/C# trill; A much improved High G/A trill; More in tune and stable High G#; A wide variety of options for extended techniques

MOUTHPIECES ARE ESSENTIAL TO OPTIMUM SOUND

A trumpet mouthpiece can change a lot in terms of sound, comfort and playability. Among the factors the mouthpiece can affect are increased endurance, enhanced high and low registers, and improved clarity of articulation. Some mouthpieces will produce brighter, higher sounds while others will produce a sound that is deeper and darker.

In the Bach system, the 'C' refers to the cup depth while the number refers to the aperture or rim diameter. A 7C has a shallower cup and smaller rim diameter compared to the 3C's deeper cup and larger rim diameter. The 5C is in between the 7C and 3C in both factors, with a deeper cup and larger rim diameter than the 7C, but shallower and smaller rim diameter cup than the 3C.

MOUTHPIECES ARE ESSENTIAL TO OPTIMUM SOUND

Cup depth is perhaps the most influential factor for tone color. Deeper cups produce darker, warmer sounds ideal for orchestral playing, while shallower cups create brighter, more projecting tones often preferred in commercial and jazz settings. Throat size affects tone density. Larger throats allow more air to pass through, creating fuller but sometimes less focused sounds, while smaller throats produce more concentrated tones. Backbore shape influences tone projection. Wider backbores tend to create a more diffuse sound that blends well in ensembles, while narrower ones produce more direct, focused tones that project better as solo voices.

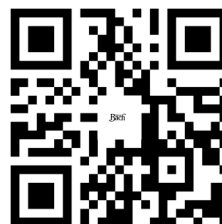



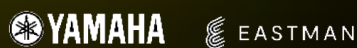
